Highlights of this year's event:

- **Wells Fargo** renewed its **presenting sponsorship** support for the fifth consecutive year, ensuring affordability to nonprofit volunteers and personnel from all sizes of nonprofits.
- **Co-sponsorship** agreements were secured with **18 nonprofit associations** (up from 12 the prior year) that promoted the event to their members in exchange for registration discount benefits offered to their member organizations.

- The first two days featured special programs for nonprofits offered by government agencies: **Congressman Ed Royce's Federal Grants Supermarket**, and the **State Board of Equalization's** tax seminar for faith-based and nonprofit organizations.
- The event's **29 separate sessions** had a combined **enrollment of 1,151**, which included **508 participants** from **355 different organizations** across **8 California counties** plus 2 from **out of state**.
- Paid attendance (168) increased slightly from the prior year (160), and included the first corporate-sponsored registrations from Warner Bros. for two of their nonprofit partners.
- In its six-year history, the event has served 1,401 individuals and engaged 32 CSUF faculty and staff from 19 departments and administrative units, plus 10 faculty and staff who awarded scholarships to nonprofit partners on whose boards they serve.
- The second annual Gianneschi Fellowship in Nonprofit Leadership was awarded to Natalie Kha for a post-baccalaureate summer fellowship at Working Wardrobes in Costa Mesa. The fellowship includes awards for both the graduate and the host site, and is funded through proceeds from the annual Gianneschi Summer School for Nonprofits.
