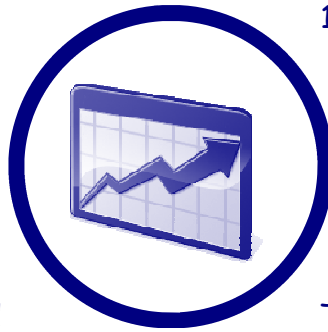

# Orange County Client Management Information System (CMIS)

## Year End Progress Report Key Metrics

The Orange County Client Management Information System (CMIS) tracks client demographic and service usage information on homeless and at risk clients served by participating Orange County service providers.



# 2008

15,443 total clients have been entered into CMIS by participating agencies since its inception in 2005. Of the 11,045 clients served in 2008, 5081 were reported to be homeless, 1,207 at-risk and 4,757 stable. The demographic information contained in this report pertains to homeless and at-risk clients only.
